TRACK UMPIRES.

Bryce recommended that we make it an additional club responsibility to provide Track Umpires. He proposes one each from Hill City, Ariki and Taieri.

Discussion followed on the rostering of clubs/parents to provide additional helpers.

- What is a fair system?...based on club numbers?
- Contribution by Country clubs at bigger events where they attend in reasonable numbers.
- Ariki point out they already supply two track officials at the finish line (Graham and Sharlene)
- We need 3 others in addition to the 2 at the finish line.
- Alex. have a system at their club nights where parents are allocated to an age group not an event. This means that parents get experience running a range of events and also get to follow their own children around.

- It is desirable but not essential that we have graded officials. The Meeting Manager can provide instruction as and when required.
- Involvement of parents is vital and is part of the means by which we keep our sport affordable and good value for money. Paying officials to officiate would result in substantially higher costs for athletes.
- Track Umpires are necessary so that week by week our athletes learn the importance of competing according to the rules by which they will be judged at meets such as Colgate Games. We do them a disservice by not familiarising them with these standards of judging.

IAAF KIT.

This will continue to be used as one of the rotations for Grades 7,8 and 9 on Interclub Saturdays. Ideally we would like to have one person to oversee the use of the kit. This person does not necessarily need to be involved in running the event but should be there to set out the equipment at the start of the morning and ensure it is all correctly packed away at the end.

A club by club roster will be set up to run the event.

Some consideration given to "appointing" a youth athlete to the overseeing role... with a financial incentive attached (possibly paying their seniors season registration?).

This is not a big role as the kit will only be used on 7 Saturdays over the entire season.

Clubs are asked to give some thought to a suitable person who might be available for this role.

Names will be considered at the next OCAC meeting and an appointment will be made.

Otago Children's Athletics Chairpersons Report

The 2012/13 Otago Children's season has been another successful year for the Otago Children's Committee.

The number of children that are club members has increased along with the number registered to compete at the Caledonian.

Otago Children's had two representative teams competing throughout the season.

We had 60 athletes competing at the end of March in Christchurch at the 995 competition for the 7-11 team. Otago finished 2nd to the Canterbury team. There were Otago Best Performances by Megan Muir 3.76m Girls 8 Long Jump, and Storm Maole 11.31m Girls 11 Shot Put.

Easter saw the Grade 12/13 team competing at the Interprovincial team competition in Timaru. Otago had a team of 44 athletes and finished in 7th place. Special mention must go to Sam Gouverneur who was the overall 6th best 12 year old boy and his results included two Otago Best Performances in the 400m (57.16 sec) and 800m (2.13.69 sec). The Grade 13 Girls 4x100m relay team set a Club Best Performance (52.26 sec), and the Boys Grade 13 4x100m relay team a Representative Best Performance (49.46 sec).

A big thank you to all the team managers and all officials that helped out during these events, we cannot do it without you.

Once again Otago Children's Athletics has been fortunate to receive sponsorship and grants throughout the season. A big thank you to Colgate Palmolive for their continued nationwide sponsorship of children's athletics.

It is encouraging to see new and familiar faces on the Otago Children's Committee. Thank you to all those people who came forward to help out at our competitions. To all officials, managers, parents, and supporters that have helped out throughout the season, a huge thank you.

995 Meeting – 2013 – Rawhiti Domain, Christchurch

The Otago team of 60 athletes travelled to Christchurch to compete in the 995 meeting on 17 March 2013, against Canterbury, Tasman and Southland.

The timing of the event, being a Sunday meant that we were not able to field a full strength Otago team with some strong athletes unavailable. With the meeting concluding at about 5pm, travel home directly after the meeting was difficult for some of our younger members.

The meeting was well run by the Canterbury officials, however the facilities were sub-standard. The grass track in New Brighton was very uneven, seeing some athletes stumble in holes on the track. Lane 2 was unable to be used due to having been re-sown, although they did use it when fields were full. The most disappointing aspect of the ground was the toilet facilities. There was a toilet in the New Brighton building, but this was not clean, and the only other toilet facilities were the Port-a-loos. These had been used the day before by Canterbury Secondary School Athletics, and were all overflowing and smeared with excrement. Hopefully Canterbury can get their act together before another Otago team returns to compete.

Our athletes were very well supported by an excellent group of managers, and great supportive parents. The final result saw Otago come second to Canterbury (who had 95 athletes competing). The results were as follows:

Our only problem with the running of the meeting was the timing of the Boys 11 1500m and High Jump. The High Jump was scheduled for 9.30am and the 1500m for 9.50am. With 2 Otago athletes competing in both, they were able to start the High Jump, but then had to marshall for the 1500m. When they returned to the high jump, the height had risen 15cm, making it nearly impossible for these athletes to have a rest and regain any rhythm to jump. Consequently their performances were well below their best. It is hard to know whether this is a programming issue, or an important thing for our selectors to note when choosing teams.

It was highly unlikely that any best performances could be achieved on the grass track, however there were two Otago best performances in the field.

Storm's performance was remarkable, improving her existing record by well over a metre, and her back-up throw was 11.24m.
